what is redemption?



REDEMPTION



Redemption

1. the action of regaining or gaining possession of something in exchange for payment, or clearing a debt.
2. the action of saving or being saved from sin, error, or evil.

REDEMPTION



Ἀπολύτρωσις (*apolutrōsis*)

1. To *ransom in full*, specifically Christian salvation.

This they said to test him, that they might have some charge to bring against him. Jesus bent down and wrote with his finger on the ground. And as they continued to ask him, he stood up and said to them, “Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her.”
