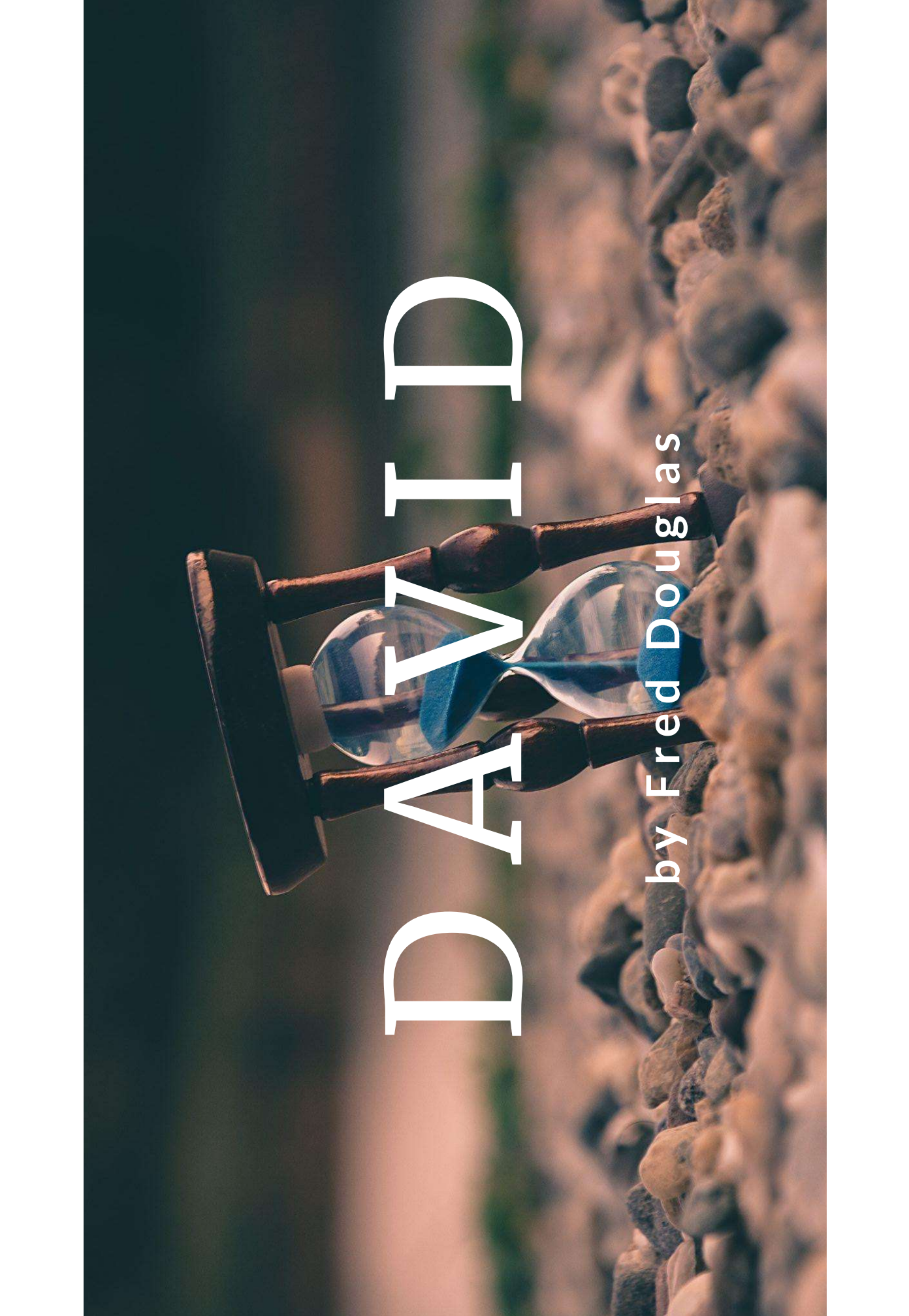

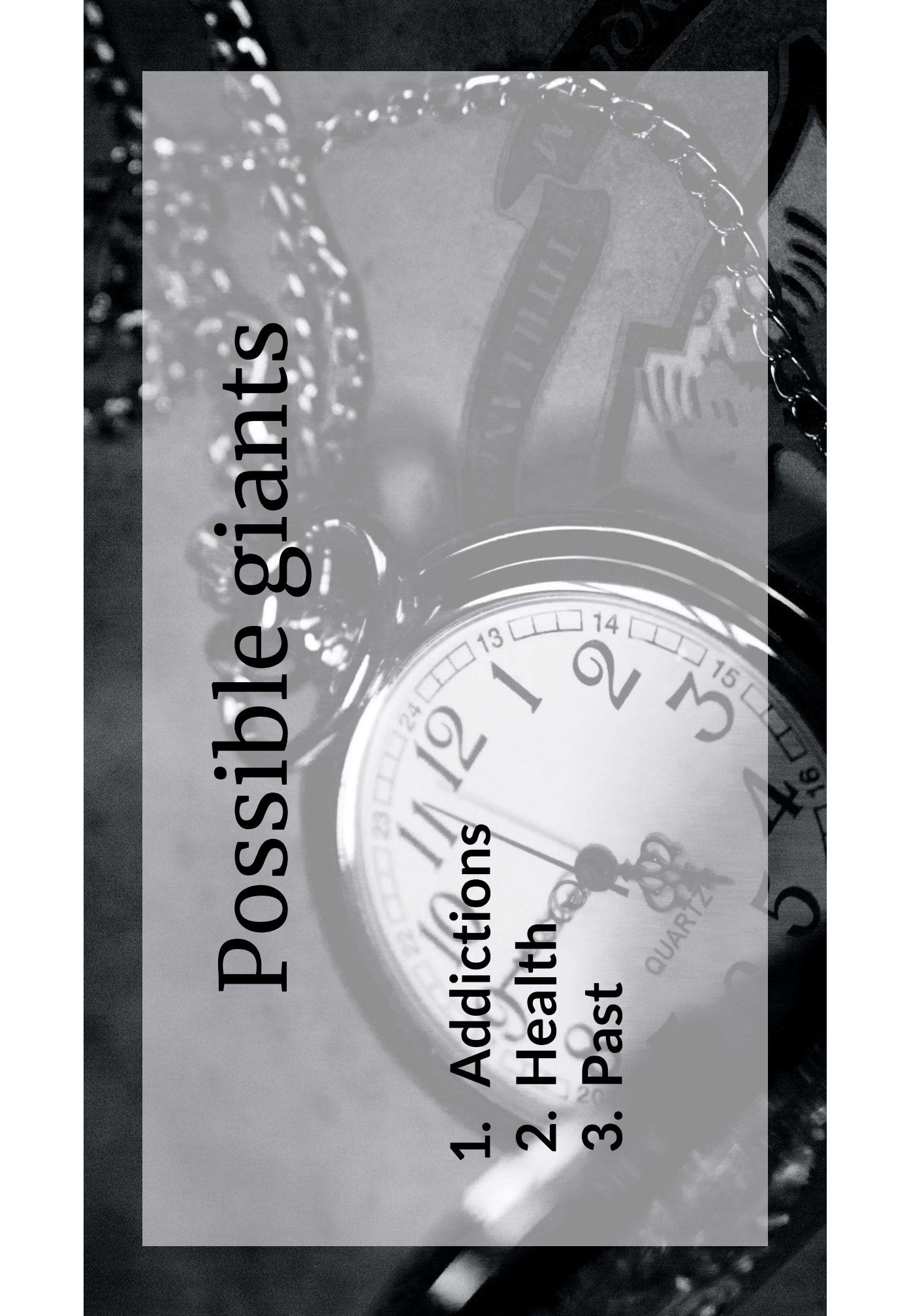

man that we may fight together.***

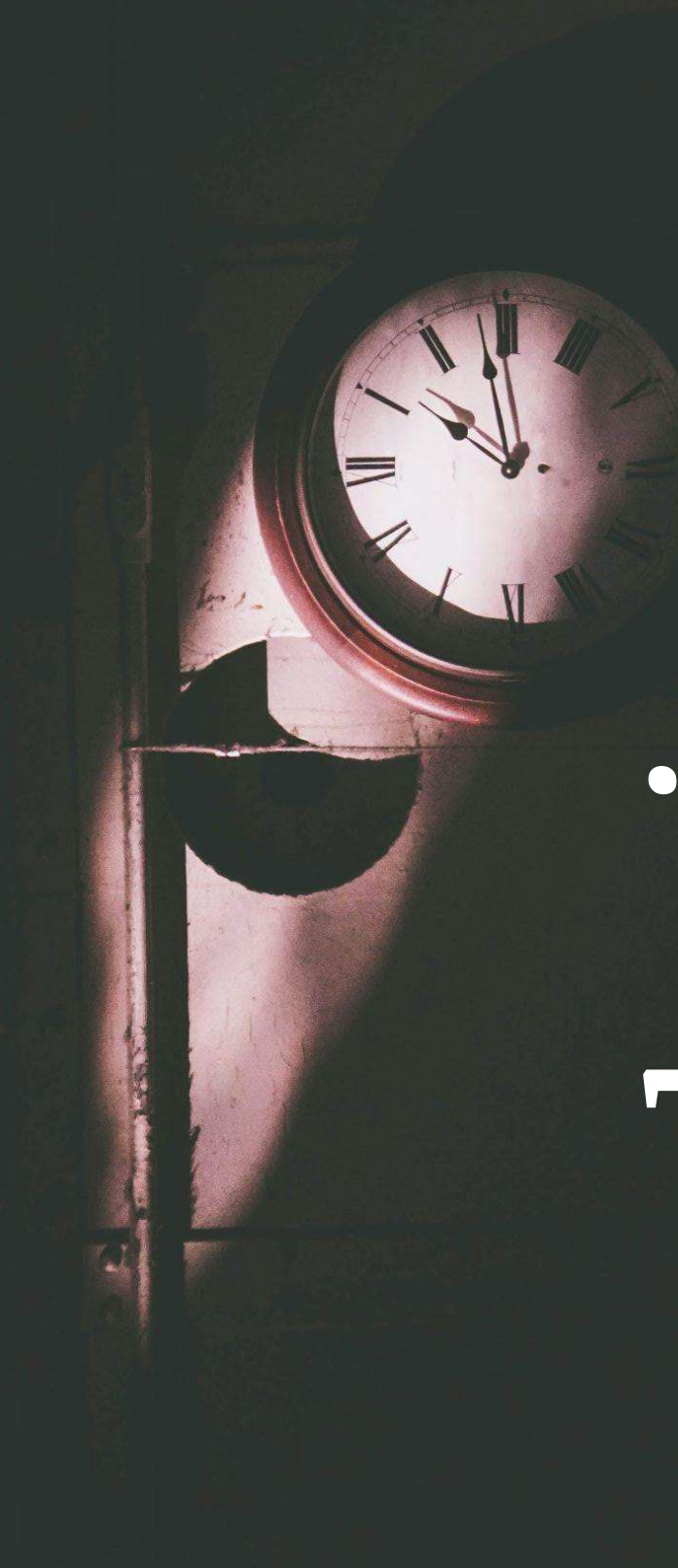
